

HOMEMADE SIDEWALK PAINT



MEASUREMENTS FOR MAKING YOUR SIDEWALK PAINT:

Add 1/4 cup plus 2 tbsp. cornstarch to each section of the container.

Add a little less than 1/4 cup of **cold** water to each section. Add just a little at a time so you don't over-do it. Whisk until the cornstarch has completely dissolved. If you've played with cornstarch and water before, you'll know that it has an interesting quality, and can turn from liquid to solid and back again depending on how much you handle it. You want your paint to be thick enough that it drizzles from the whisk.

Add your food coloring, and stir well.

Now you're ready to hit the sidewalk (or in this case, the driveway).
